Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Championships:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2017. 2. Signed the Athlete's Agreement for the 2017 SEA Games. 3. Attained a score equivalent to the bronze medal score of the last SEA Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets, or have beaten the 3rd placed diver/synchronized pair in the last SEA Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets. 4. Continues to train for peak diving performance. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Extenuating circumstances can include but is not limited to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Injury or Illness ii. Equipment Failure iii. Travel Delays iv. Bereavement 5. Where 3 or more individual divers have met the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period in an event, a final selection trial will be held by May 2017 to select the top 2 individual divers for nomination. The highest scoring synchronized pair in any selection event during the qualifying period will be selected for nomination. 6. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Attitude and behaviour; b) Current skill level and fitness; c) Level of commitment and training attendance; d) Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with team mates and officials

Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athletes Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute.
Team Size	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. With the approval of SNOC, SSA intends to send 2 representatives per each individual event, and 1 synchronised pair per synchronised and mixed event. 2. The selection committee will decide on the 2 representatives for the team event, based on their ability to attain the highest total score. The 2 representatives must have qualified for the individual or synchro events.
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports. Appeals	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The appeal process shall be made as a process of enquiry against the selection process, policies and decision. It does not serve as a reselection process. 2. The appeal process shall not be made against the scores given by the judges during the competition. 3. Any appeal must be written officially to Singapore Swimming Association within 5 working days after the official announcement of the selection results. 4. The Appeal Panel's decision is final.
