Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Championships:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2019. 2. Signed the Athlete’s Agreement for the 2019 Southeast Asian Games. 3. Attained a score equivalent to 3rd place score of the last Southeast Asian Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets, or have beaten the 3rd placed diver/synchronized pair of the last Southeast Asian Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets. 4. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions during 6 months leading up to the Games. 5. Where 3 or more individual divers, or, 2 or more synchronised pairs have met the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period in an event, a final selection trial will be held by July 2019 to select the top 2 individual divers or top synchronised pair for nomination. 6. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Attitude and behaviour; b) Current skill level and fitness; c) Level of commitment and training attendance; d) Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with team mates and officials
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute.
Team Size	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. With the approval of SNOC, SSA intends to send 2 representatives per each individual event, and 1 synchronised pair per synchronised event.
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports. They are also the governing body that selects the athletes for the Games, and considers any appeal cases which the NSAs may submit.</p> <p>The SSA selection committee will consist of the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diving Head Coach • Member of the SSA Exco • Representative from the Diving High Performance Committee • Executive Director, SSA • SSA FINA Listed Judge <p>The appeals committee will consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • President of Singapore Swimming Association • Secretary General of Singapore Swimming Association • Ho Mun Wai
Appeals	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The appeal process shall be made as a process of enquiry against the selection process, policies and decision. It does not serve as a reselection process. 2. The appeal process shall not be made against the scores given by the judges during the competition. 3. Any appeal must be written officially to Singapore Swimming Association within 5 working days after the official announcement of the selection results. 4. The Appeal Panel's decision is final.
