Eligibility	<p>To be considered for nomination to SNOC, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Championships:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2021. 2. Signed the Athlete’s Agreement for the 2021 Southeast Asian Games. 3a. Attained an ‘A’ qualifying score equivalent to 3rd place score of the last Southeast Asian Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets, or have beaten the 3rd placed diver/synchronised pair of the last Southeast Asian Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets. 3b. Where 3 or more individual divers, or, 2 or more synchronised pairs have met the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period in an event, a final selection trial will be held by July 2021 to select the top 2 individual divers or top synchronised pair for nomination. 3c. Where only one or no divers qualify under the ‘A’ score for individual event, or no synchronised pair qualifies under the ‘A’ score, a Junior diver/synchronised pair who attains a minimum ‘B’ qualifying score equivalent to 4th place score of the last Southeast Asian Games in which the event was held, in any one of the approved meets, may be considered for nomination by the SSA selection committee. A junior diver must be aged 18 years old and under as of 31 Dec 2021. 4. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions for 6 months leading up to the Games. 5. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. Current skill level and fitness; c. Level of commitment and training attendance; d. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials

Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute.
Team Size	With the approval of SNOC, SSA intends to send 2 representatives per each individual event, and 1 synchronised pair per synchronised event.
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports. They are also the governing body that selects the athletes for the Games, and considers any appeal cases which the NSAs may submit.</p> <p>The SSA selection committee will consist of the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diving Head Coach • Member of the SSA Exco • Representative from the Diving High Performance Committee • Executive Director, SSA • SSA FINA Listed Judge <p>The appeals committee will consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • President of Singapore Swimming Association • Secretary General of Singapore Swimming Association • Ho Mun Wai
Appeals	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The appeal process shall be made as a process of enquiry against the selection process, policies and decision. It does not serve as a reselection process. 2. The appeal process shall not be made against the scores given by the judges during the competition. 3. Any appeal must be written officially to Singapore Swimming Association within 5 working days after the official announcement of the selection results. 4. The Appeal Panel's decision is final.
