# Singapore Swimming Association collaborates with Republic Polytechnic to leverage synergies

## SSA and RP sign MoU supporting the development of aquatic sports in Singapore

**Singapore, 23 October 2015** – Singapore Swimming Association (SSA) and Republic Polytechnic (RP) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), aimed at increasing the quality of aquatic sports in Singapore.

The three-year agreement will see Republic Polytechnic's School of Sports, Health & Leisure formalise its partnership with Singapore Swimming Association in the following areas:

- **Sport science support** – more SSA athletes will get to work with students and faculty from RP and receive full sports science support, further enhancing their current training programmes.
- **Events** – RP students will have the opportunity to volunteer and take on Final Year Projects and internships involving SSA.
- **Coach development** – RP's faculty members and academics will assist with the Syllabus of Coaches Accreditation Program and continuing education courses for coaches.
- **Programme management** – RP and SSA will collaborate in the research, development and implementation of best practices in aquatics, for example the Singapore Swimming Proficiency Award (SSPA).
- **Talent and development** – RP will extend invitations to SSA's coaching and High Performance department to attend conferences or workshops in areas related to the sport industry. At the same time, students from RP will get the chance to acquire industry experience through attachments and internships with SSA.

“Through the MoU, we will conduct joint projects while tapping on the expertise of RP's lecturers and students to help SSA strengthen its development pathways across all four aquatic disciplines. In addition, the mutually beneficial collaboration will enhance sport science support for athletes while providing RP students with relevant industry experience,” said Mr Edwin Ker, Executive Director, Singapore Swimming Association.

Speaking at the MoU signing ceremony, Ms Goy Soon Lan, Director, School of Sports, Health & Leisure, Republic Polytechnic, said: “This MOU between Singapore Swimming Association and Republic Polytechnic's School of Sports, Health and Leisure marks a key milestone for sport in Singapore. SSA proactively approached RP to offer customised sports workshops and certified programmes to the aquatic fraternity in the area of coaching, sports management and sports science.”

“Working with the Singapore Sports Institute and its Coaching Academy, RP and SSA will complement each other through shared expertise in supporting the needs of the coaches and

high-performance managers, raising the bar for coaching standards and delivering enhanced performance.”
