SNOC Key Dates	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Longlist restart deadline – 1 May 2023 (new)</b></li> <li>2. Nomination deadline – 25 Mar 2022</li> <li>3. Selection Committee Meeting – 18 Apr 2022</li> <li>4. <b>Appeal deadline – 16 May 2023</b></li> <li>5. <b>Appeal Committee mtg – 7 Jun 2023</b></li> <li>6. <b>NSA Entry By Name deadline – 30 Jun 2023</b></li> </ol>
Team Size	With the approval of SNOC, SSA intends to send 2 athletes per each individual event, and 1 pair of athletes per synchronised event, up to a maximum of 8 male athletes and 8 female athletes.
Eligibility	To be considered for nomination to SNOC, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Games: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of <b>31 Dec 2023</b>.</li> <li>2. Signed the Athlete Agreement.</li> </ol>

	<p>3a. Attained a qualifying score equivalent to 6<sup>th</sup> place score of the last Asian Games (i.e. 2018 Asian Games Jakarta) in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets, or have beaten the 6<sup>th</sup> placed diver/synchronised pair of the last Asian Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets listed above.</p> <p>3b. Where 3 or more individual divers, or 2 or more synchronised pairs have met the qualifying criteria in an event during the qualifying period, the top 2 individual divers or top synchronised pair, will be nominated to SNOC.</p> <p>3c. The remaining quota spots, after the nomination deadline, may be filled by individual divers or synchronised pairs based on scores from the Selection Events by SSA Appeal to SNOC.</p> <p>4. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions for 6 months leading up to the Games.</p> <p>5. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would be constituted as doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By law.</p> <p>6. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attitude and behaviour;</li> <li>Current skill level and fitness;</li> <li>Level of commitment and training attendance;</li> <li>Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials</li> </ol>
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times.</li> <li>Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required.</li> <li>Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA.</li> <li>Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute.</li> </ol>
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his/her non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the official announcement of the selection results and inform of his/her intent to appeal.</li> <li>The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his/her appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver.</li> <li>If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final.</li> </ol>

	Note : <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i>
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports. **Addendum**

Due to extraordinary circumstances during the Covid-19 pandemic, the selection policy has been updated to include:

- Updated dates of qualifying competitions
- Inclusion of results from 2018 Jakarta Asian Games
- Inclusion of qualification for Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games

**Addendum part 2 (following new dates of Games from 23 Sep to 8 Oct 2023)**

- Updated dates of competition, qualifying events and key dates
- The athletes selected at the Selection Committee Meeting on 18 April 2022 will remain. There will not be another Selection Committee Meeting.
- The athletes already selected on 18 April 2022 will remain. However, the selection window will be extended for all to compete to get data points on an equal footing. For example, if there is an event with a maximum of 2 competitors per country; and one (Athlete A) has been already selected, his/her selection is not automatic. If there are three more athletes (B, C, D) meeting the SNOC Selection Criteria in the extended window, another trial will be conducted after the extended window, before entry by name deadline, to select the best two athletes from A, B, C, D.
