Eligibility	<p>A diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Games:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen. 2. Be at least 18 and no older than 27 years of age on 31 Dec 2023. 3. Be a student currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a recognised university or institute, or a former student who have obtained degree or diploma in the last 3 calendar years (i.e. 2020, 2021 and 2022).

	<p><i>Note: Age and graduation year limits have been extended to allow those who met the conditions in 2021 to participate in 2023.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Be a registered member of SSA in good standing. 5. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By-law. 6. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. General conduct and past disciplinary record; c. Current skill level and fitness; and character; d. Level of commitment and training attendance; e. Potential for future development; f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials 7. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competition for at least 3 months leading up to the Games.
Qualifying Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Qualifying criteria is based on Individual events only. Selection for Synchronised or Team events will be determined after Individual divers have qualified. 2. Met performance standards as recommended by the Singapore University Sports Council (SUSC) – achieved at least the 18th place score (qualifying score for Semi-Finals) of the event in the last FISU World University Games. Refer to Annex A for qualifying scores. 3. Scores must have been achieved in an individual event in one of the approved selection events. Exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances resulting in an athletes inability to compete in and/or attend event. On request of SSA, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. Extenuating circumstances can include but is not limited to: i. Injury or Illness ii. Equipment Failure iii. Travel Delays iv. Bereavement, and v. Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant. 4. In addition to the minimum qualifying scores, divers must have a dive list with a minimum degree of difficulty (DD), comparable with international standards and the last FISU World University Games. Refer to Annex B for minimum DD. 5. Any eligible diver who wishes to participate, and has met or is on track to meeting the qualifying criteria, must give written confirmation to Sport Manager (Diving) at least one week before the Quantitative Entries deadline. 6. Where 4 or more divers meet the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period, a final selection trial will be held before the Individual Entries by Name deadline.

Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign the current SSA Athlete’s Agreement and comply with the provisions of the SSA Athlete Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute. 5. Divers are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SSA’s objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SSA Athlete’s Agreement as per Point 1.
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results and inform of his intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p><i>Note:</i> <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
