Eligibility	<p>A diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Games:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen. 2. Be at least 14 years of age on 31 Dec 2023. 3. Be a registered member of Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) in good standing. 4. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or

	<p>used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS, WADA or AQUA's Anti-Doping By-law.</p> <p>5. In addition to the qualifying criteria below, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Attitude and behaviour; General conduct and past disciplinary record; Current skill level and fitness; and character; Level of commitment and training attendance; Potential for future development; Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials <p>6. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competition for at least 3 months leading up to the Games.</p>
Qualifying Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Qualifying criteria is based on Individual 3m and 10m events only. Selection for other events will be determined after divers have qualified. Divers must perform a dive list with a minimum degree of difficulty (DD), comparable with international standards, OR, achieved at least 95% of the 18th place preliminary score of the event at the Budapest 2022 World Championships. Refer to Annex A for minimum DD and suggested dive list, and Annex B for the minimum qualification score (MQS). A diver is deemed to have met the qualifying criteria if he meets either the total minimum DD and/or MQS. Divers must have competed in the Individual event in one of the approved selection events. Any eligible diver who wishes to participate in the World Championships, and has met or is on track to meeting the qualifying criteria, must inform the Sport Manager (Diving) at least one month before the Entries by Name deadline. Where 3 or more divers meet the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period, a final selection trial will be held before the Entries by Name deadline.
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Sign the current SAQ (SSA) Athlete's Agreement and comply with the provisions of the SAQ (SSA) Athlete Agreement at all times. Conform to SAQ requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAQ. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SAQ into public disrepute. Divers and officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SAQ's objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SAQ Athlete's Agreement as per Point 1.

Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the announcement of the selection results and inform of his intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p><i>Note:</i> <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
