Team Size	<p>With the approval of SNOC, SSA intends to send 2 athletes per each individual event.</p> <p>The confirmed list of events for the 32nd SEA Games, Cambodia 2023 are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Men 3m Springboard 2. Women 3m Springboard 3. Men Platform 4. Women Platform
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for nomination to SNOC, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Games:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2023. 2. Be a registered member of SSA in good standing. 3. Signed the current SSA Athlete’s Agreement. 4. Met performance standards as designated by Singapore National Olympic Committee (SNOC), achieved at least the 3rd place score of the last SEA Games in which the event was held – defined as an ‘A’ qualifying score in the table below;

	<p>or have beaten the 3rd placed diver of the last SEA Games in which the event was last held.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Scores must have been achieved in an individual event in one of the approved selection events. b. Exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances resulting in an athletes inability to compete in and/or attend event. On request of SSA, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. Extenuating circumstances can include but is not limited to: i. Injury or Illness ii. Equipment Failure iii. Travel Delays iv. Bereavement, and v. Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Where only one or no divers qualify under the 'A' score for individual event, a Junior diver who attains a minimum 'B' qualifying score, 5% off the 3rd place score of the last SEA Games in which the event was held, may be considered for nomination by the SSA selection committee. A junior diver must be aged 19 years old and under as of 31 Dec 2023. 6. Where 3 or more divers meet the qualifying criteria during the qualifying period, a final selection trial will be held before the nomination or appeal deadline to select the top 2 divers. 7. If any diver meets the qualifying criteria but chooses not to compete in the event, written notice must be given to the Team Manager and Vice President (Diving), before the nomination or appeal deadline. 8. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions for 6 months leading up to the Games. 9. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By-law. 10. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Attitude and behaviour; b. General conduct and past disciplinary record; c. Current skill level and fitness; and character; d. Level of commitment and training attendance; e. Potential for future development; f. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times. 2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute. 5. Divers and Officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SNOC's and SSA's objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. These obligations will be further outlined in the SNOC and SSA Athletes and Officials Agreement as per Point 1.
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his/her non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the official announcement of the selection results and inform of his/her intent to appeal. 2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his/her appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver. 3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final. <p>Note : - <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports.
