Addendum (SNOC)	<p>Addendum part 2 with effect from 15 May 2022 (with the announcement of the postponement of the Asian Games, new dates of the Games from 23 September to 8 October 2023)</p> <p>1) The athletes selected at the Selection Committee Meeting on 18 April 2022 will remain. There will not be another Selection Committee Meeting.</p> <p>2) The Appeals Committee meeting scheduled on 27 May 2022 has been postponed, with the new date for this meeting on 7 June 2023.</p> <p>3) The selection window will be extended to the month before the Entry-By-Name deadline 30 June 2023. Henceforth, NSAs can use upcoming competitions (including the 32nd SEA Games) as data points for submission to the Appeals Committee.</p> <p>4) The athletes already selected on 18 April 2022 will remain. However, the selection window will be extended for all to compete to get data points on an equal footing. For example, if there is an event with a maximum of 2 competitors per country; and one (Athlete A) has been already selected, his/her selection is not automatic. If there are three more athletes (B, C, D) meeting the SNOC Selection Criteria in the extended window, the NSA will be required to have an addendum to the selection policy that the best two athletes from A, B, C, D will be selected. Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet all the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Championships:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Singapore citizen, eligible to represent Singapore. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Athletes must be <u>Singapore Citizens, and should not be holding dual citizenship if they are above 21 years old</u>, at the time of nomination. 2. Be a registered member of SSA in good standing. 3. Have a signed current SSA Athlete Agreement. 4. Met performance standards as designated by Singapore National Olympic Committee (SNOC), 6th place timing at the 2018 Asian Games. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Times must be achieved in an individual event; relay lead-off times, intermediate splits or swim-off results will not be considered for individual event selection purposes. 5. Have competed and qualified in at least one of the selection events stated in the previous section or a designated accredited meet if based overseas, unless granted an exemption under the provisions of the criteria by the SSA Selectors. 6. This exemption will only be granted due to extenuating circumstances. On request of SSA, evidence shall be provided of the extenuating circumstances, prior to the exemption being considered. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Extenuating circumstances can include but is not limited to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Injury or Illness ii. Equipment Failure iii. Travel Delays / Restrictions iv. Bereavement v. Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant. 7. Continues to train for, behave and act towards peak swimming performance. 8. Be available to fulfil the Team Commitments as listed below and any additional commitments following selection. 9. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or

	<p>committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS's, WADA or FINA's Anti-Doping By-law.</p> <p>10. No individual can perform the role of both participating swimmer and coach at the same meet.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The individual shall declare their intention upon selection of their specific role. b. Each individual will declare their role upon signing either the Athletes' Agreement or Coaches' Agreement
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers and officials must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign and comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athletes and Officials Agreements at all times. 2. Conform to SSA and SNOC requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SNOC and SSA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the SNOC, athlete or SSA into public disrepute. 5. Swimmers and Officials are required to appear at events and platforms whereby their images and presence are needed to achieve SNOC's and SSA's objectives of giving back to the Sport and the wider community. Performance Requirements	<p>Selection Priority: Swimmers will be selected for nomination to SNOC by the following priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individual A Qualifiers 2. Relay Alternates 3. Individual B Qualifiers <p>Addendum:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Times from all swimmers' events selected as part of the original selection process ending in April 2022 will remain in the rankings. 2. All times from selection meets post April 2022 Selections will be added to the rankings. 3. The top 2 athletes per event will be submitted to SNOC as appeals for individual event selection. 4. The top 6 100 free and 200 free swimmers will be submitted to SNOC as appeal for 4 x 100 and 4 x 200 free relay selection 5. The top 2 swimmers per Medley Relay stroke will be submitted to SNOC as appeal for 4 x 100 Medley Relay Selection. 6. B Standards will only be submitted for appeals consideration should any individual event have less than 2 swimmers with the A standard. 7. The selection standards from the original selection process remain the same with only the qualification window extended to May 16, 2023. 8. New Depth Charts will be posted at conclusion of each selection meet on the SSA website here. <p>To be considered for selection for individual events for the 19th Asian Games 2022, swimmers are required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Achieve an A-Time Standard as shown below in Table 1 within the qualification window <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The Automatic Qualifying time set by SNOC for this championship is based on the 6th placed time at the 2018 Asian Games b. Achieving this standard automatically qualifies you to be nominated to the 19th Asian Games 2022, given that you are one of the two fastest swimmers at the conclusion of the qualifying period 16 May 2023. 2. Achieve as Juniors: Boys 19 and under, and Girls 18 and under on December 31, 2023, a B Time Standard as shown in Table 1, at one of

	<p>the designated selections meets during the selection window through 16 May 2023.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Swimmers achieving B-Time Standards will be nominated if there are open spaces in those events after selection of A qualifiers and relay alternates. b. B-Time Standard is equal to the faster time between 2% off the 6th place time at the 2018 Asian Games and 8th place at the 2018 Asian Games. c. Swimmers who are nominated via a B-Time Standard will be submitted to SNOC as an appeal and subject to the decision of SNOC. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. A maximum of 2 swimmers per event may be considered for selection. Swimmers with a B-Time Standard will be nominated based on open events up to a maximum of 2 swimmers per event. 4. Should two or more swimmers achieve the same qualifying time at the selection meets then the swimmer's second fastest time (and subsequent times should there continue to be a tie) in that event during the selection meets will be used to determine which swimmer is selected. 5. Relay lead-offs or splits will not be considered for selection for individual events. <p><u>Nomination for Additional Events:</u></p> <p>At the discretion of the National Head Coach, Technical Director and Selection Committee, at the conclusion of SNOC selection process, ALL swimmers selected for the 2022 Asian Games, through the selection process (meaning they have been named to the official team roster), are available swimmers for additional events (events in which they haven't achieved the qualifying criteria) if there are open spots.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Swimmers will be ranked by times for all events they have results from the qualification window 2. Swimmers will be added to open events based on rankings 3. No swimmer will be added to an event that could affect the outcome of their selected events. 4. If a swimmer declines an additional event, the next available swimmer will be offered the spot. 5. SSA is not obligated to fill all spots with available swimmers should there not be a viable swimmer available. <p><u>Criteria for Nomination for Relay Events:</u></p> <p>All swimmers selected to the official team roster for 2022 Asian Games are considered available and eligible for relay positions as determined by the National Head Coach and staff at the championship meet.</p> <p>Freestyle Relays</p> <p>Swimmers will be nominated by the following priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Consideration for the 4 x 100 and 4 x 200 free relays. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Fastest 2 Qualified individual swimmers for the 100 and 200 freestyle events b. For each 100m & 200m Freestyle events, up to 4 additional athletes may be nominated for selection as per ranking from the selection window. c. Relay Lead-off times ARE considered for relay-only nomination

	<p>d. The 4 slowest swimmers combined times must make the relay qualifying standard for the relay, as per Table 1 for consideration.</p> <p>Medley Relays</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The medley relays will be selected at the meet from the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The fastest combination, meaning the fastest swimmer available during the course of the meet, including: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. the fastest individual distance (100m) of stroke during the Asian Games 2022 championships or, ii. an individual posting a faster time during the selection window who not necessarily swims that event at the Asian Games due to conflict with other events. 2. Should no individual swimmers for each of the form strokes (Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Freestyle) be selected to the official team roster: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The fastest swimmer of the form strokes will be nominated to form a medley relay <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. The combined time of swimmers must make the qualifying standard for the relay, as per Table 1 for consideration. b. Alternate stroke swimmers may be nominated for selection: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Should the maximum team size not yet be filled. ii. Suitable alternate is not already available through other selected events iii. The combined time of swimmers including alternates must make the qualifying standard for the relay, as per Table 1 for consideration. <p>General Relay Information</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The final decision of the composition of the relays will be made by the National Head Coach in consultation with National Technical Director and team coaches at the Games. The four best swimmers on day of competition from any event (not necessarily qualified on the relay or individual 100 or 200 freestyle events) may be called to step up to represent Singapore. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Selection criteria for composition of relays at the meet will be based on, but not limited to the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Individual race performances during the meet ii. Historical reference of available athletes and their performances at the meet. 2. Relay-Only swimmers selected and named to the official team roster, are available for additional events as selected swimmers. (see criteria for Additional Events in Performance Criteria)
Team Size	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. With the approval of SNOG, SSA intends to send 2 representatives per each individual event and fill all qualified relay positions. 2. The fastest 2 qualifying swimmers of each individual event within the qualifying window will, by default, be automatically nominated to represent Singapore at the 19th Asian Games 2022. If the 2 fastest qualifying

	<p>swimmers choose not to swim in a particular individual event, the slot will go to the 3rd fastest qualifying swimmer in the event and so on.</p> <p>3. SSA shall not be obligated to take a full team of two athletes per event should a qualifying athlete or suitable developing athlete not be available for selection.</p> <p>4. Coaches Selection	<p>SSA will nominate the Head Coach candidate to SNOC for 19th Asian Games 2022 selection.</p> <p>Subject to the approval of SNOC, the number of additional coaches selected will depend on the number of swimmers selected with a maximum ratio of 1:4 (1 coach x every 4 swimmers), based on the ranking of the swimmers selected to the Games. (<i>Rankings based on World Ranking 2 per country 1 September 2021 to 31 August 2022</i>).</p> <p>The coaches will be selected in accordance to the following priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Coaches with swimmers ranked in the top 40 World Rankings. 2. Number of swimmers that have achieved the A-Time Standard. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. First, highest ratio swimmers with A cuts to coach of record; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. When more coaches than spots available, swimmers will be ranked by their highest World Ranking. 3. Number of swimmers that have achieved the B-Time Standard. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Swimmers will be ranked by their highest World Ranking for coach selection. <p>The nominated coach of an athlete must be the coach of record for at least 3 months prior to the athlete's selection to the 19th Asian Games 2022 and remain the coach of record through 19th Asian Games 2022.</p>
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports. With consideration of any special circumstances as described in section 7 - Eligibility in this document. c. The appeals committee may request additional information from the athlete's club through SSA HPM if necessary, to further deliberate on the merits of the appeal. d. The committee will provide the HPM with outcome of the appeal to correspond to the said swimmer through their club. e. Appeals submitted by SSA to SNOC for consideration of a swimmer post SNOC team selection. The process of appeal is as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. SSA HPM submits the appeal with evidence* directly to SNOC for review. b. SNOC reviews the appeal and corresponds to SSA the outcome of the appeal. c. SSA corresponds the outcome of the appeal to the club of the said swimmer. d. Review and decision of the appeal by SNOC is final. <p>*SSA shall submit an appeal to SNOC on merits warranted by SSA that serve the desired performance outcomes of the team.</p>
